FAQs

Q: Can students attending Japanese school participate in the Little Brown Summer School Program?

A: Yes! As long as the student can follow the curriculum. Note: This is NOT an ESL program.

Q: Can I register my child for one week of summer school?

A: Unfortunately, for the sake of continuity, students must register for either 3 or 4 weeks for Term 1. Term 2 in August gives choices of 1 or 2 weeks for elementary students.

Q: Can I register my son/daughter for one class in the morning and one in the afternoon?

A: Unfortunately not. The program is structured in a way that all grades from K to 12 will be participating in the program 9am to 2:40pm.

Q: What about lunch? Is it supervised?

A: Students will have about 50 minutes for lunch. They can bring packed lunch from home or buy their lunch from shops nearby.

Q: What if my child is sick?

A: Please contact us at 045-263-6331 in case of any absences by 8:30am. Please note that there are no makeup days or refund built into the program.

Q: What do I bring on the first day?

A: Books for the ES book clubs and math exercise sheets will be provided by the school. Grades 4/5 students should bring your iPads for weeks 1 and 2 for the Coding class. MS and HS students should bring their own laptops. Students in all grades should bring writing utensils, writing paper or notebook (any type) and water (thermos or bottle water) and lunch.
